



LOCAL RULES

BUNKERS. (Rule 12)

- All the areas of Volcanic sand that surround the greens are considered bunkers, even though they are not surrounded by grass.

- Stones in “bunkers” are loose impediments (Rule 12-2).

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS.(Inamovable obstructions).(Rule 16.1)

- All paved or cemented roads.
- The whole water system.
- Small artificial walls and stone lines.
- The areas marked with white lines or blue stakes are considered ground under repair

- **Relief:** the player can drop in the nearest relief point without penalty and without gaining any distance towards the hole, conforming with the Rule 16-1.

The player can't get relief if the ball is in, or is touching penalty areas (Rule 17)

OUT OF BOUNDS. (Rule 18.2)

- The white stakes to the left of hole 5 Links Course are out of bounds, only for that hole (hole 4 Links Course not included).

- The areas of sand that exist on the lateral parts of the fairways are considered rough.
- Tee areas for holes 5 and 9 Links Course are considered penalty areas for the game, but not for Tee-off of these holes. (Rule 17.1)
